**HEART PINE:** Is a degree beneath oak in density & hardness. Its yellow to slightly reddish colors are enhanced with grains that vary from open to tight.



**WHITE PINE:** Is a soft wood with a tight grain and a glowing amber color.



**WHITE OAK:** Has a natural golden hue that is handsomely distressed.



**CHESTNUT:** Has a variety of natural distressings from age old worm holes to natural knots and its natural colors range from amber to luxurious browns that can't be beat.



**HEMLOCK:** This open grained softwood has a charming distressed look that's created by small knots that are enriched by a variety of mellow amber tones.



**CHERRY:** Is the royalty of woods. For centuries it has been the wood of choice for fine furniture. Your Cherry wood floor will take on these same values.
